7c. Ordinance Certifying Substantial Accordance with Illinois Public Act 103-0281

Description: Legislation enacted in 2023 requires the RTA Service Boards (CTA, Metra, and Pace) to publish monthly operational performance measures and for the RTA Board to vote and annually certify that the agencies are in substantial accordance to the State. The proposed ordinance certifies that CTA, Metra, and Pace are in substantial accordance with the requirements of Illinois Public Act 103-0281.

7d. Ordinance Adopting the 2025 Budgets, 2026-2027 Financial Plans, and 2025-2029 Capital Programs of the Service Boards and Authority and Appropriating Funds for the 2025 Budgets
