

- Planned bond issuances delayed to match the timing of funds needed



#### CTA – Reconnecting Communities Neighborhoods (RCN) Grant

- Awarded to projects that help access, and equitable development and restoration
- CTA's award adds \$111M for track and structure along Blue Line – Forest Park Branch between Kedzie and Pulaski





## CTA – Strengthening Mobility and Revolutionizing Transportation (SMART) Grant

- Awarded to demonstration projects focused on advanced smart community technologies and systems
- CTA's award adds \$1.5M to the program for a Bus Queue Jump Signal Program





#### Pace – Low- No-Emissions Buses Grant

- Awarded to projects related to low- or no-emission buses, and rehabilitating existing facilities to accommodate low- or no-emissions buses operations
- Pace's award adds \$30.9M for purchasing hybrid buses

- Metra is requesting the extension of the following four projects

  - Crew Optimization
  - Platform Heating Technology
