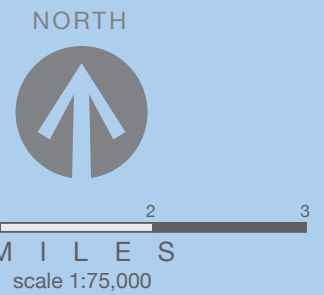

Regional Transportation Authority

The Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) provides financial oversight, funding, and regional transit planning for the three public transit operations in Northeastern Illinois that serve two million riders each weekday: The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA), Metra and Pace bus and paratransit. The Agency provides customer services including on-line and telephone travel planning assistance and travel training for people with disabilities. The RTA is the only transit agency that focuses on the entire region when determining transit planning and funding. The RTA region has a population of approximately eight million people throughout six counties and 7,200 transit route miles. For more information, visit rtachicago.org

CTA, Metra and Pace

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) runs bus and elevated/subway trains in Chicago and nearby suburbs. For current fare and schedule information, visit transitchicago.com

Metra provides commuter rail services to 243 stations throughout the region serving Chicago and its suburbs. For complete fare and schedule information, visit metra.com

Pace moves people throughout the Chicago region with fixed bus routes, Dial-a-Ride, On Demand, and other community transit programs. Most Pace bus routes connect with Metra and CTA service. For schedules and fares, visit pacebus.com

Transit Partners

South Shore Line runs trains on the Metra Electric line from downtown Chicago to South Bend, Indiana, serving the Southeast Side of Chicago and Northwest Indiana. For schedules and fares visit mysouthshoreline.com

CTA and Pace Fares

Ventra™ is the region's fare payment system. Ventra Transit Accounts can be loaded with value and passes using the Ventra App, cash, coins or bankcard at any Ventra vending machine or with credit/debit cards online and by phone. Ventra Cards can now be added to an Android device with Google Pay or iPhone or Apple Watch.

Cash is accepted on buses, but free transfers are not possible. A new cash fare must be paid on each bus.

CTA and Pace Passes

Passes offer unlimited rides on CTA and/or Pace when activated with first use. Passes are loaded onto a Ventra transit account or contactless bankcard.

Metra Day Pass

Good for unlimited rides on a single service day. The \$6 Day Pass is valid for travel within one to three fare zones—anywhere, not just for trips downtown; the \$10 Day Pass is valid for travel systemwide. Day Passes are only available on the Ventra App.

Metra Weekend Pass

Metra offers a \$7 Saturday or Sunday Day Pass for unlimited rides on either Saturday or Sunday, and a \$10 Weekend Pass (available on the Ventra App only) for unlimited rides on both weekend days. Not valid for travel on the South Shore (NICTD).



Amtrak provides rail service from Chicago's Union Station to cities throughout Illinois and United States. Many of these routes, combined with Thruway buses, connect 35 Illinois cities. For more information, visit amtrak.com

Accessibility

Metra has 243 commuter rail stations, of which 190 are fully accessible and 11 are partially accessible. The CTA "L" train system includes 145 stations, of which 103 are fully accessible. All CTA and Pace buses are ramp-equipped and make automated stop announcements. Metra Fares

Metra Mobile Tickets and Passes can be purchased using the Ventra App. Fares are based on distance traveled. The fare schedule below is for fares based on travel to/from downtown Chicago (Zone A). Under the Fair Transit South Cook pilot, all riders on the Metra Electric and Rock Island lines will be charged Metra's reduced fare rates for all tickets.

Metra Super Saver Monthly Pass

The Super Saver Monthly Pass is valid for unlimited travel on Metra lines throughout the Chicago area, on any line at any time, and is available through Metra ticket agents and the Ventra App. Full-fare passes cost \$100, while reduced-fare passes are \$70.

Regional Connect Pass

Holders of the Super Saver pass can also purchase the Regional Connect Pass, offering unlimited rides on CTA and Pace, with no time or day restrictions, for an entire month. Cost to Super Saver pass holders is \$30. Visit transitchicago.com and pacebus.com for further details.

Children's Fares

Children pay reduced fares on CTA, Metra and Pace based on their age. On Metra and Pace, children under the age of 7 are not permitted to travel without a fare paying customer.

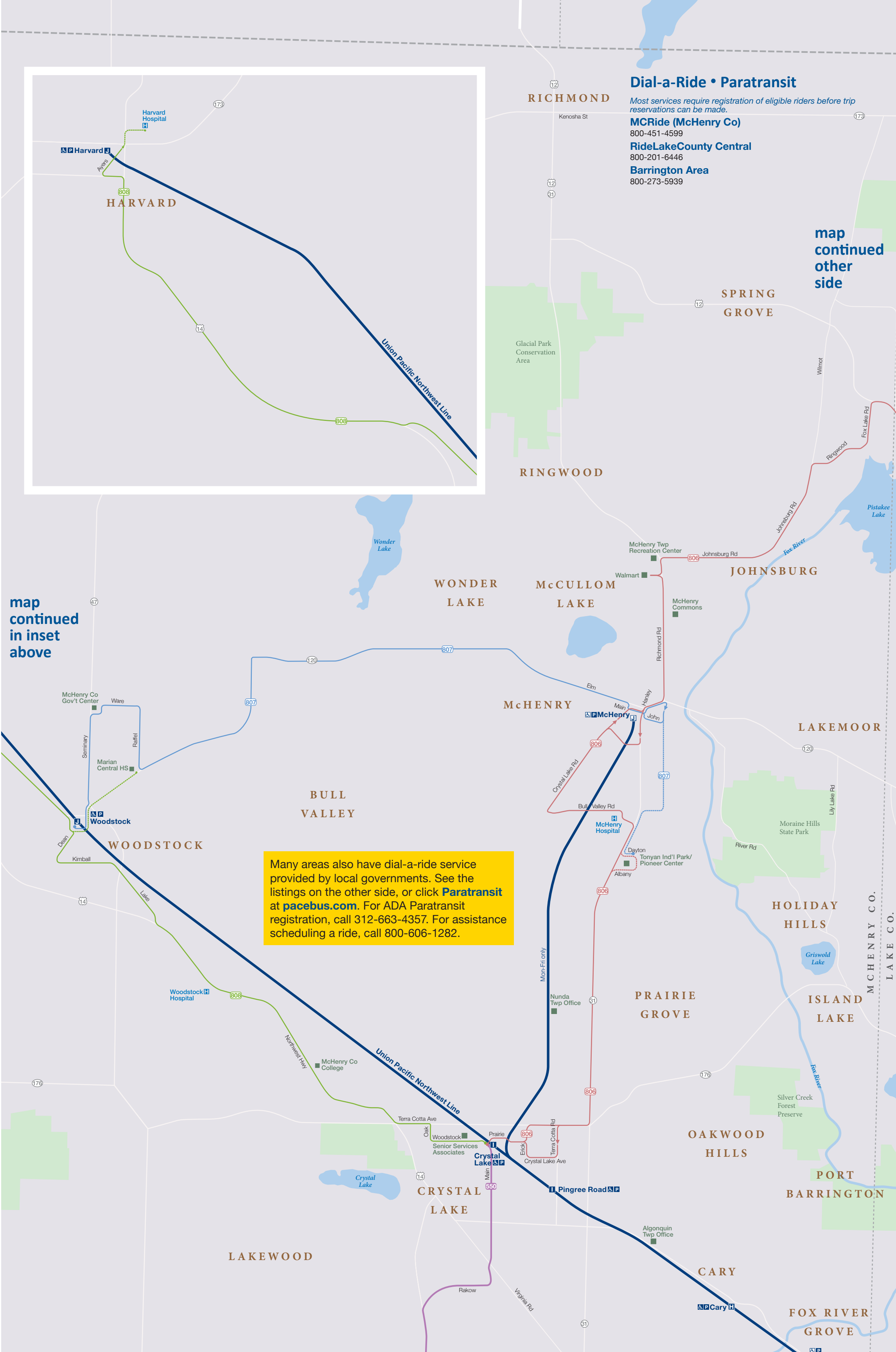

NICTD (South Shore Line) Fares

South Shore Line fares are based on distance traveled. There are four basic ticket types; one-way, 10-ride, 25-rides, and monthly tickets. Reduced fares are available for senior citizens and customers with disabilities. Please note that Metra tickets and passes are not valid on South Shore Line trains. 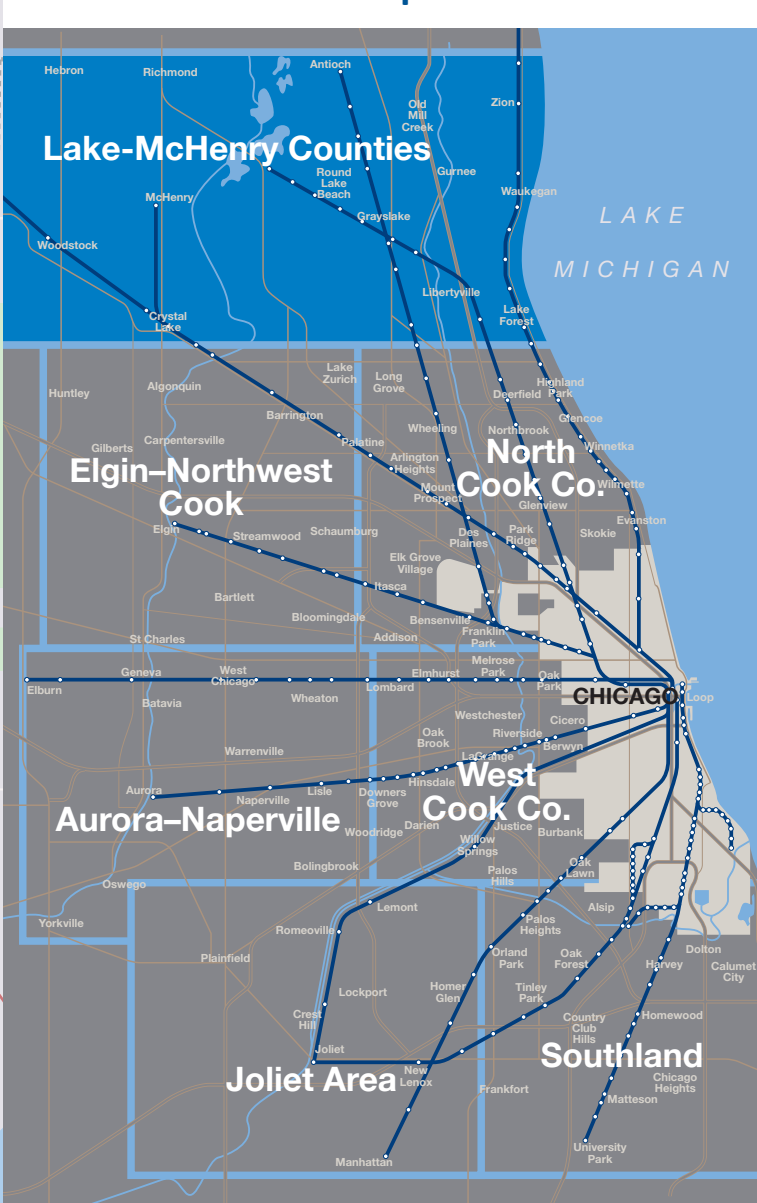
